BATTERY-POWERED AIR COMPRESSOR BY STIHL



Whether you're inflating tyres, air mattresses or footballs, a manual pump can be both time consuming and strenuous. Available from January 2025, the new KOA 20 battery-powered air compressor can do the hard work for you without the hassle of a power cable.

Thanks to its compact and lightweight design (1.5 kg without battery), the KOA 20 can be stored conveniently in the car boot or garage. The large handle with rubberised grip also makes transportation easy, while the wide sturdy base keeps the tool steady for a clear view of the LED screen.

The KOA 20 has a maximum pressure of 150 PSI or 10.3 bar, making it suitable for vehicle tyres and other high-pressure items such as inflatable boats. In the high-volume mode, the KOA 20 has a maximum air flow rate of 360 l/min, perfect for low pressure items such as mattresses or toys. The automatic switch-off feature prevents items from being overinflated.

Important information such as the battery charge level and pressure setting are displayed on the large LED screen, and the simple controls make adjusting the settings as easy as possible.

All the necessary valve adapters and tubes are stored underneath the base of the tool, meaning you'll always have the parts required to inflate a wide variety of items.

Part of the STIHL AS System, the KOA 20 uses the AS 2 battery and has a working time of up to 23 minutes, depending on usage mode. Other tools in the AS System include the new RCA 20 pressure washer, the new BGA 30 blower and much more.
