A new battery-powered top handle chainsaw from STIHL





Launching in Spring 2025, the new MSA 190 T offers arborists and tree work professionals a powerful alternative to the petrol MS 194 T. Like all tools in the AP System, the MSA 190 T has been developed with demanding daily use in mind, while remaining lightweight, quiet and easy to maintain.

Weighing 3.2 kg (with guide bar & chain, without battery), the MSA 190 T is comfortable to use for long periods, and when used with the recommended AP 200 S battery, is perfectly balanced too. To reduce the weight further, an AP Strop Adapter accessory can be used to transfer the weight of the battery to the operator's hip. An integrated lanyard protects the cable, and the adapter can easily be integrated into the users climbing harness.

The MSA 190 T is equipped with the new Power Boost function, temporarily increasing the maximum electrical output of the battery from 1.25 kW to 1.5 kW. This ensures the MSA 190 T can keep cutting through larger timber, reducing the likelihood of bogging down and maximising the working time of the battery.

A mechanical trigger system means that a time-out deactivation system is not required, making the MSA 190 T simple to operate.

The MSA 190 T is available in 12" or 14" versions and is equipped with the STIHL PS3 Pro 1.1mm chain. Compared to the standard STIHL PS3 chain, the PS3 Pro has up to 20%

improved cutting performance, and is less pressure sensitive when using the entire length of the guide bar.

Like many AP System battery-powered tools, the MSA 190 T is quiet in operation, aiding communication between teams working on the ground and in the canopy.

A long working time of up to 48 minutes with the AP 200 S battery ensures minimal disruption during the working day. This can be extended to a maximum of 75 minutes with the AP 300 S, or an impressive 90 minutes with the AP 500 S.

The MSA 190 T completes the line-up of three AP System top handle chainsaws. The MSA 161 T is a popular choice for pruning jobs thanks to its lightweight design and 1/4P chain. Thanks to the 14" guide bar and high-power output, the MSA 220 T is well suited to large cutting tasks. The new MSA 190 T sits in between the two models and is suitable for a wide range of applications for maximum versatility.
