Like all STIHL battery-powered machines, the SEA 60 features a highly efficient brushless motor, developed with low wear and durability in mind. The SEA 60 meets dust class L, making it suitable for cleaning normal house dust, as well as other substances such as sand, plaster and chalk.

Part of the STIHL AK System of battery-powered tools, the SEA 60 is recommended with the AK 20 battery and has a working time of between 16 and 26 minutes, depending on the selected power level. Over 20 other tools feature in the AK System, ranging from lawnmowers and grass trimmers to power washers and chainsaws.
